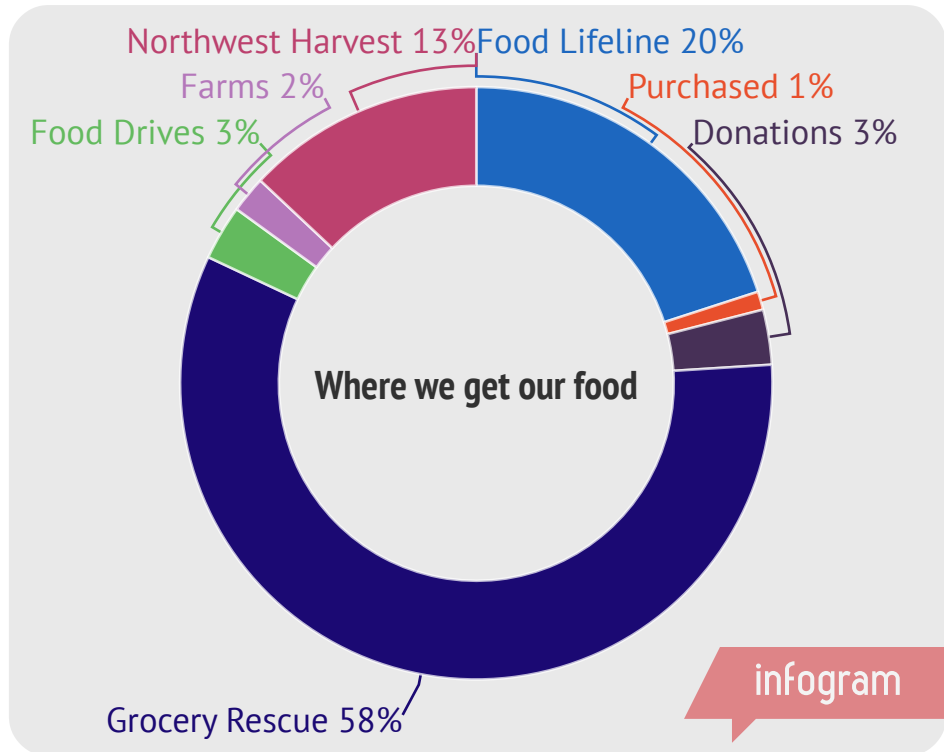
People Served



Pounds of Food Distributed

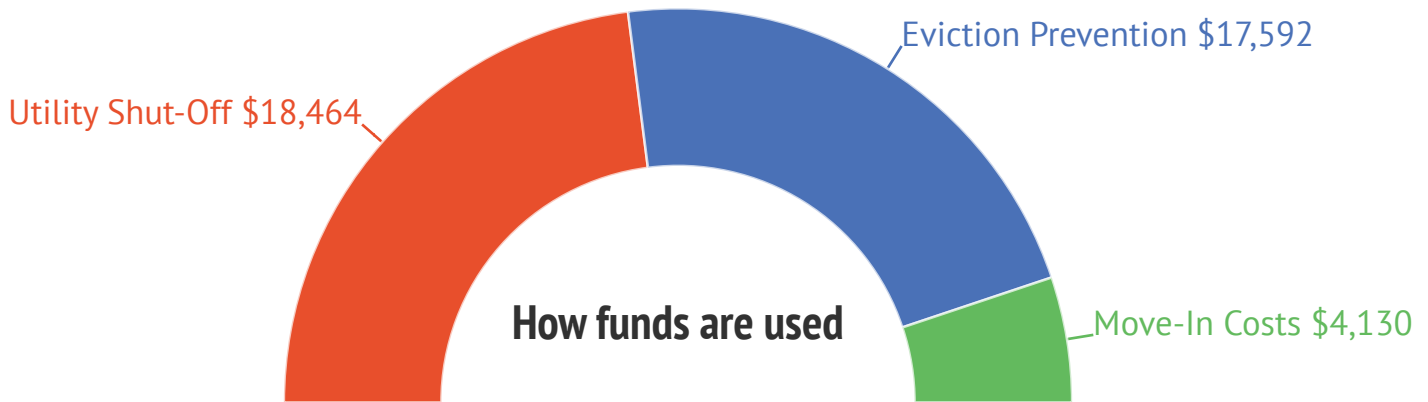

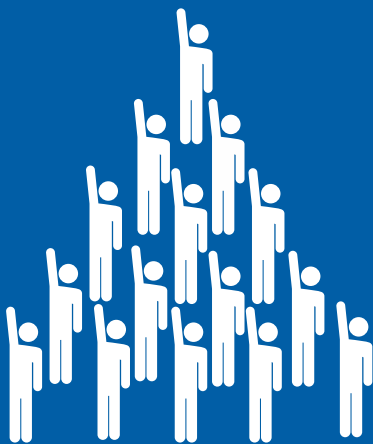

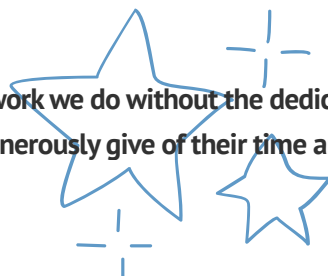
